



CONSERVATION DOGS OF HAWAII

SCENT DETECTION WORKSHOP STRUCTURE AND RULES

1. The structure of the workshop dictates that one dog work at a time. Other dogs will remain secured in their car or crated until their turn.
2. Please always keep your dog on a leash unless he/she is in the search area and you are instructed to take the leash off.
3. When walking to or from the search area, or out in the potty area, please keep dogs a safe distance from each other. No meet and greets between dogs please.
4. Make sure to potty your dog before the workshop starts and possibly before each search. The nature of the work may trigger the desire to eliminate and we would like to avoid the dog potty-ing in the search area. If your dog still eliminates in the search area, please don't reprimand your dog....leave it be and we will clean up.
5. Please minimize chatting during the dogs' runs.
6. Instruction may vary based on an individual dog's need.
7. The dogs will work on leash at first but may eventually work off leash within an enclosed area.
8. If a dog solicits social contact during the search, please ignore them.
9. Please leave toys and treats in your car when it is not your dog's turn so that the search area is clear of distractions for other dogs.
10. Be patient with your dog. Don't get frustrated.
11. Please don't say "No" or "Leave it" to your dog during searches. The instructor will set your dog and the search environment up for success.
12. Feel free to ask questions any time.
13. Video-ing of your own dog is allowed during runs.
